- Bakuchiol (pronounced "buh-KOO-chee-all") is a "naturally occurring antioxidant found in the seeds of Psoralea Corylifolia, a plant found in Eastern Asia. This plant is used in Indian & Chinese traditional medicine.
- Clinical studies have confirmed that bakuchiol is a true retinol-like functional compound without the negative effects of retinol. (<u>Source</u>)
- Bakuchiol visibly reduces fine lines, wrinkles and acne.
- Good for those with sensitive skin, mature skin, and acne prone skin.
- Also goes by Babchi Seed.

### **Bakuchiol for Anti-Aging**

- Bakuchiol mimics the functionality of retinol, without the negative effects, such as safety and stability.
- Clinical studies have proven reduction of fine wrinkle depth and skin roughness in human subjects over a 12 week time span.
- Bakuchiol stimulates more collagen reproduction than retinol.
- It is clinically proven to protect skin from UV-induced damage.



### Bakuchiol for Acne

- Bakuchiol has anti-bacterial properties which make is ideal for treating *Propionibacterium acne*.
- Bakuchiol can help with the four symptoms of acne: excessive sebum production, over production of bad bacteria, inflammation, and hyperkeratinization.
- Bakuchiol can help switch off an enzyme which degrades/oxidizes collagen; which means it can help smooth out skin and help prevent ice pick acne scars.



## How can I use Bakuchiol in my formulations?



### **Formulation Guidelines**

- Suggested use level is 0.5% to 1.0% (w/w) of finished formulation.
- Add Bakuchiol to the formulation after making emulsion with a processing temperature of about 50°C.
- Can be included during the oil phase.
- Protect from prolong exposure to heat and light to conserve integrity.
- Small amount of chelating agent can be used to counteract coloration in the final product.
